Detailed Rationale & Key Rating Drivers

CARE had, vide its press release dated April 30, 2020, placed the rating K. P. Industries (KPI) under the 'Issuer non-cooperating' category as KPI had failed to provide information for monitoring of the ratings as agreed to in its rating agreement. KPI continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails, phone calls and a letter dated March 16, 2021, March 26, 2021, April 05, 2021 etc. In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE's opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

Users of this rating (including investors, lenders and the public at large) are hence requested to exercise caution while using the above ratings.
