Detailed Rationale & Key Rating Drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated April 21, 2021, placed the rating(s) of Hyper Filtration Private Limited (HFPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as HFPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating and had not paid the surveillance fees for the rating exercise as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. HFPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails, phone calls and a letter/email dated March 07, 2022, March 17, 2022, March 27, 2022.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

The company undertakes EPC (engineering, procurement and construction) contracts for setting up zero discharge plants for textile industry, water treatment, sewage treatment and industrial effluents treatment plants, machinery and equipment's on turnkey basis. The main raw materials for the company are pipes, sheets and coils made of mild steel and stainless steel which is procured domestically.
