### Detailed Rationale & Key Rating Drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated September 13, 2021, placed the rating(s) of Lalit Polyplast Private Limited (LPPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as LPPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating and had not paid the surveillance fees for the rating exercise as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. LPPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails, phone calls and a letter/email dated July 30, 2022, August 10, 2022, August 19, 2022.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

Incorporated in 2014, Lalit Polyplast Private Limited (LPPL) was promoted by Mr. Lalit Kumar Jha and Mrs. Anubha Jha, is engaged in trading of polymers and plastic raw materials like Poly Vinyl Chloride (PVC) resin, PVC paste resin, polypropylene granules, high-density polyethylene granules, low-density polyethylene granules, and linear low-density polyethylene granules, plasticisers and other polymers. The products of the company are used in making plastic containers, pipes, tanks, lamination, automobile industry etc. The company has warehouses in Delhi, Bawana and Faridabad having storage capacity of 300 M.T., 300M.T. and 450 M.T. respectively.
