Detailed Rationale & Key Rating Drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. has withdrawn the outstanding rating of 'CARE AA; Stable/ CARE A1+' [Double A; Outlook: Stable/A One Plus] assigned to the bank facilities and instruments of Tata Steel BSL Ltd with immediate effect. The above action has been taken as the company has been amalgamated into and with Tata Steel Ltd under the composite scheme of amalgamation approved and sanctioned by the Hon'ble National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT), Mumbai Bench, pronounced on October 29, 2021. Therefore, it may no longer be useful or necessary for CARE Ratings Ltd. to maintain a rating on the rated entity's debt obligations.

Incorporated in the year 1983, Tata Steel BSL Limited (erstwhile Bhushan Steel Limited) is among the largest steel players in the industry and forms a part of Tata Steel Limited which indirectly owns 72.65% stake in the company. The company has an annual capacity of 5.60 million tonnes (mt). The company has presence in the value-added products segment. It caters mainly to the auto industry and consumer-durable makers through its various manufacturing facilities situated in Dhenkanal (Orissa), Ghaziabad (Uttar Pradesh), Khopoli (Maharashtra), and Hosur (Tamil Nadu).
