Rationale & Key Rating Drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated November 19, 2021, placed the rating(s) of Chemsol Labs Private Limited (CLPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as CLPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating and had not paid the surveillance fees for the rating exercise as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. CLPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails, phone calls and a letter/email dated October 05, 2022, October 15, 2022, October 25, 2022.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

Incorporated in August, 2006 as "Chemsol Labs Private Limited" (CLPL), by Mr Vamsi Krishna (Managing Director) and his wife Mrs Swarna Kumari (Director), to carry on trading of pharmaceuticals (Pharma) products. The company also undertakes manufacturing of certain pharmaceutical products (APIs and formulations) and chemicals which is in the nature of conversion under loan licenses. The company does not have its own manufacturing facilities and gets the manufacturing done by way of job work. CLPL deals with around 70 pharma products (trading and manufacturing).
