Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated February 09, 2023, placed the rating(s) of Ganapati Builders Limited (GBL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as GBL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating and had not paid the surveillance fees for the rating exercise as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. GBL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails, phone calls and a letter/email dated December 26, 2023, January 05, 2024, January 15, 2024.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

The company gives construction activities of its projects to contractor and it focus mainly on marketing aspects. The promoters have satisfactory business experience of more than two decades in real estate industry.
