Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated May 24, 2023, placed the rating(s) of Kalyanram Rice Industries (KRI) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as KRI had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating and had not paid the surveillance fees for the rating exercise as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. KRI continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails, phone calls and a letter/email dated April 08, 2024, April 18, 2024, April 28, 2024.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

KRI is engaged in milling and processing of rice. The operations of the firm were started in the year 2009. The rice milling unit of the firm is located at Miryalguda (Telangana). Apart from rice processing, the firm is also engaged in selling by-products such as broken rice, husk and bran and trading of paddy.
