Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated May 26, 2023, placed the rating(s) of Vinshil Polychem (VP) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as VP had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating and had not paid the surveillance fees for the rating exercise as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. VP continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails, phone calls and a letter/email dated April 10, 2024, April 20, 2024, April 30, 2024.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.
