Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated April 17, 2023, placed the rating(s) of Mahalaxmi Associates Private Limited (MAPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as MAPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating and had not paid the surveillance fees for the rating exercise as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. MAPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails, phone calls and a letter/email dated March 02, 2024, March 12, 2024, March 22, 2024.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

The group is also into coal mining business in Nagaland through Mahalaxmi Mining Pvt. Ltd. This apart, the group through Mangalam Enterprises is also involved in trading of rice, pulses, sugar, mustard oil and other dairy products.
