## Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated May 31, 2023, placed the rating(s) of M M Barels Industry (MMBI) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as MMBI had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating and had not paid the surveillance fees for the rating exercise as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. MMBI continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails, phone calls and a letter/email dated April 15, 2024, April 25, 2024, May 05, 2024.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

Andhra Pradesh Based, M M Barels Industry (MMBI) was established in October 29, 2014 by Mr. Doraswamy Naidu (Managing partner), Mr. Rajaram Partner, Mr. Purushotaman (partner) along with family members. The firm and commercial operation started in December 17, 2015. MMBI is engaged in manufacturing of mild steel drums and barrels of 200 Ltrs and 20 Ltrs capacity which are mainly used by food processing companies, oil companies, Paint and Ink industries etc. The current installed capacity for manufacturing of Mild Steel Drums and Barrels is 10200 numbers per month.
