Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated August 09, 2023, placed the rating(s) of Raja Cotton Industries (RCI) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as RCI had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating. RCI continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails, phone calls and a letter/email dated June 24, 2024, July 04, 2024, July 14, 2024.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.
