Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated July 28, 2023, placed the rating(s) of GN Poultry Farms (GPF) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as GPF had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating. GPF continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails, phone calls and a letter/email dated June 12, 2024, June 22, 2024, July 02, 2024.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

Telangana based GN Poultry Farms (GPF) was established as a partnership firm in the year 2011. GPF was promoted by Mr. Ramchandra Reddy and Mr. Narsi Reddy. The firm is engaged in layer poultry farming and wholesale trading of eggs. The firm has an installed capacity of 20,000 layers in 7 sheds as on February 28, 2018. The firm sells its products, eggs, cull birds, and manure to the customers located in Telangana, Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka. The firm purchases inputs for feeding of birds like maize, soya, broken rice, shell grit and minerals from local traders.
