CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated August 21, 2023, placed the rating(s) of Earth Home (EH) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as EH had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. EH continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails, phone calls and a letter/email dated July 06, 2024, July 16, 2024 and July 26, 2024.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.
