Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated July 25, 2023, placed the rating(s) of S. M. Autostar Private Limited (SMAPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as SMAPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. SMAPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated June 09, 2024, June 19, 2024 and June 29, 2024 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.
