Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated August 28, 2023, placed the rating(s) of Sanghavi Jewel Private Limited (SJPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as SJPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. SJPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated July 13, 2024, July 23, 2024 and August 02, 2024 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

Sanghavi Exports International Pvt Ltd (SEIPL) (rated CARE D; Issuer Not Cooperating), the flagship company of the group, holds 91.02% shares in SJPL. SEIPL is engaged in the processing of rough diamonds and export of cut and polished diamonds. SJPL is engaged in the manufacturing and export of studded gold, silver and platinum jewellery using polished diamonds, precious and other semi-precious stones.
