### Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated June 16, 2023, placed the rating(s) of AL-Ameen Charitable Fund Trust (ACFT) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as ACFT had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating. ACFT continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails, phone calls and a letter/email dated August 23, 2024, August 27, 2024, August 28, 2024.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

The ratings assigned to the bank facilities of ACFT have been revised on account of non-availability of requisite information.
