### Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated October 03, 2023, placed the rating(s) of Dynamic Refractories (DR) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as DR had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. DR continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated August 18, 2024, August 28, 2024 and September 07, 2024 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.
