### Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated August 28, 2023, placed the rating(s) of SD MilkPro Private Limited (SMPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as SMPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. SMPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated July 13, 2024, July 23, 2024 and August 02, 2024 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.
