Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated November 28, 2023, placed the rating(s) of Shree Balaji Coal Traders Limited (SBCTL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as SBCTL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. SBCTL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated October 13, 2024, October 23, 2024, November 02, 2024 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

Users of this rating (including investors, lenders and the public at large) are hence requested to exercise caution while using the above rating(s).

The ratings assigned to the bank facilities of SBCTL have been revised on account of non-availability of requisite information.

About the company

SBCTL, incorporated in 2002, promoted by Kolkata based Late Mr. S. M. Bhutoria, is engaged in the trading of coal and coke and providing services relating to transportation and handling of coal. SBCTL procures coal mainly from Coal India Ltd. and its subsidiaries. The company has four warehousing facilities at Dhankuni (WB), Cuttack, (Odisha), Ramgarh (Jharkhand) and Singrauli (MP).

Status of non-cooperation with previous CRA: CRISIL has continued the rating assigned to the bank facilities of SBCTL into ISSUER NOT COOPERATING category vide press release dated December 19, 2023 on account of its inability to carry out a review in the absence of requisite information from the company.

Brickwork has continued the rating assigned to the bank facilities of SBCTL into ISSUER NOT COOPERATING category vide press release dated March 14, 2024 on account of its inability to carry out a review in the absence of requisite information from the company.
