Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated October 19, 2023, placed the rating(s) of Logan Ceramic (LC) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as LC had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. LC continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated September 03, 2024, September 13, 2024 and September 23, 2024 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

About the Firm

Established in 2007, Morbi (Gujarat) based Logan Ceramic (LC) is a partnership firm engaged in the business of manufacturing and trading of tiles and ceramic body powder used in manufacturing of tiles. LC is established by Mr. Gopalbhai Rankja, Mr. Alpesh Parecha and 10 other partners. LC initially started with manufacturing of ceramic body powder used in manufacturing of tiles. From April 2015 onwards, LC also started manufacturing of tiles.

Status of non-cooperation with previous CRA: CRISIL has continued the ratings assigned to the bank facilities of LC into 'Issuer not-cooperating' category vide press release dated November 24, 2023 on account of non-availability of requisite information from the Firm.
