Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated December 11, 2023, placed the rating(s) of Sarvottam Atta Private Limited (SAPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as SAPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. SAPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated October 26, 2024, November 05, 2024, November 15, 2024 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

SAPL was established as a proprietorship firm by Mr. Jilubhai Chauhan in 2005 and was reconstituted as a private limited company in June 2014. SAPL is engaged in the business of grain processing (wheat) and produces flour and semolina (rava) and sells it under the brand name 'Vanraj'. Its manufacturing facility is located at Sihor in Gujarat and operates with an installed capacity of 200 metric tonnes per day.
