Rationale & Key Rating Drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated December 22, 2023, placed the rating(s) of Saify Interiors (SI) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as SI had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. SI continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated November 06, 2024, November 16, 2024, November 26, 2024 and January 08, 2025 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

Users of this rating (including investors, lenders and the public at large) are hence requested to exercise caution while using the above rating(s).

The ratings have been revised on account of non-availability of requisite information. The rating revision also considers ongoing delays in debt servicing recognised from publicly available information.
