## Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated January 30, 2024, placed the rating(s) of Everest Sea Foods Private Limited (ESFPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as ESFPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. ESFPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated December 15, 2024, December 25, 2024 and January 04, 2025 among others. In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information

Mangalore based, Everest Sea Foods Private Limited (ESFPL) was incorporated on June 07, 2012 and started its commercial operations from October, 2012. The company is currently managed by Mr. Waseem Machiwala, Mr. Sanjay K Jaokar, Mr. Sumeet Jaokar and Mr. Sindhuram Puthram who has more than three decades of experience in the sea food industry. The company is engaged in processing, packing and exporting of marine products.

**Status of non-cooperation with previous CRA:** ICRA has continued the rating assigned to the bank facilities of ESFPL into Issuer Not Cooperating category vide press release dated January 17, 2024 on account of its inability to carry out a review in the absence of requisite information.
