## Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated February 13, 2024, placed the rating(s) of Riyara Trading (RT) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as RT had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. RT continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated December 29, 2024, January 08, 2025, January 18, 2025 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

#### **About the Firm**

Riyara Trading (RT) was established on April 1, 2014 by Mr. Saravanan C (Proprietor). RT established in 2014 is involved mainly in trading of bulk Cement. RT deals in various grades of cement such as OPC43, OPC53, PPC, Slag cement which is used for general constructions, RCC Structures, Multi storied buildings etc.

**Status of non-cooperation with previous CRA:** Acuite has continued the rating assigned to the bank facilities of RT into Issuer Not Cooperating category vide press release dated December 11, 2023 on account of its inability to carry out a review in the absence of the requisite information from the firm.
