Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated February 28, 2024, placed the rating(s) of Corodex Infrastructure Private Limited (CIPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as CIPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. CIPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated January 13, 2025, January 23, 2025 and February 02, 2025 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

About the company

CIPL was incorporated in June 2013 by Mr Prakash Arun, Mr Ankur Kumar Saxena and Mr Bidyut Chattopadhyay. The company started operations from August 2014. CIPL is engaged in the electrical infrastructure supply, erection, commissioning of transmission line, grid substation, power substation & mechanical work on turnkey basis.

Status of non-cooperation with previous CRA: CRISIL has continued the rating assigned to the bank facilities of CIPL into Issuer Not Cooperating category vide press release dated March 20, 2024 on account of its inability to carry out a review in the absence of requisite information.
