Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated May 02, 2024, placed the rating(s) of Satguru Agro Industries Limited (SAIL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as SAIL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. SAIL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated March 18, 2025, March 28, 2025 and April 07, 2025 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

SAIL was incorporated in November 1991 at Solapur, Maharashtra which was promoted by Khaitan family. During 2004, SGAIL was acquired by current management which includes- Mr. Praffulbhai G. Kalavadia, Mr Dinesh Kumar M. Kalavadia, Mr. Bharatbhai V. Changela, Mr. Paresh Kiran Parmar, Mr. Kantilal Naranbhai Padodar and Mr. Ashiwin Kumar Dayabhai Zalawadi. SGAIL is engaged in the crushing and processing of soyabean seed for extraction of soya de-oiled-cake (DOC), soya wash oil and soya refinery.
