Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated May 06, 2024, placed the rating(s) of CFI Ventures Private Limited (CVPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as CVPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. CVPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated March 22, 2025, April 01, 2025 and April 11, 2025 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.
