Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated May 17, 2024, placed the rating(s) of RMJ Modern Rice Mill (RMRM) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as RMRM had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. RMRM continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated April 02, 2025, April 12, 2025, April 22, 2025 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

RMRM, engaged in rice milling business, was established in June 2006, by Mr J. Thangapandi and Mr J. Sundarapandian as a partnership firm sharing profits and losses equally. The raw material, paddy is procured from farmers in and around the districts of Madurai, Theni, Usulampati and Sivagangai.

Status of non-cooperation with previous CRA: CRISIL has continued the rating assigned to the bank facilities of RMRM into ISSUER NOT COOPERATING category vide press release dated February 24, 2025 on account of its inability to carry out a review in the absence of requisite information from the firm.
