Rationale & Key Rating Drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated May 03, 2024, placed the rating(s) of Swastik Cement Products Private Limited (SCPPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as SCPPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. SCPPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated March 19, 2025, March 29, 2025, April 08, 2025 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

The firm primarily engaged in the manufacturing of Mild Steel (MS) ingots. The company has its manufacturing facility located at Chandauli, Uttar Pradesh. Also, the company is engaged in manufacturing of wheat flour on job work basis for Swastik Grains Corporation (associate firm). SCPPL has an associate concern namely Swastik Grains Products Private Limited, which was incorporated in March, 2007 and is engaged in processing of wheat flour.
