Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated May 21, 2024, placed the rating(s) of ShelL-N-Tube Private Limited (SPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as SPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. SPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated April 06, 2025, April 16, 2025 and April 26, 2025 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.
