Rationale & Key Rating Drivers

CARE Ratings Limited (CareEdge Ratings) had, vide its press release dated August 29, 2024, placed the rating(s) of S.S.T Packaging Private Limited (SPPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as SPPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. SPPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated July 15, 2025, July 25, 2025, August 04, 2025 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CareEdge Ratings has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CareEdge Ratings' opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

About the company

S.S.T Packaging Private Limited (SPPL) was incorporated in 2016 by Mr. Tanmay Kumar and Mrs. Snigdha Kumar based out of Kolkata, West Bengal for setting up a manufacturing unit for paper poly coating and paper cups. The commercial operation of the company has started from July 2017 onwards. The company has been engaged in manufacturing of paper poly coating & paper cups at its plant located at Sonarpur, Kolkata, West Bengal. The company procures its raw materials from Japan, China and Kolkata and it sells its products in the domestic market.

Status of non-cooperation with previous CRA: CRISIL has continued the rating assigned to the bank facilities of SPPL into ISSUER NOT COOPERATING category vide press release dated November 22, 2024 on account of its inability to carry out a review in the absence of requisite information from the company.
