VPIPL was established as a partnership concern, by the name Vishal Paper Industries, in 2002, by Vidya Sagar Gupta and his brothers Suraj Bhan Gupta and Krishan Mohan Gupta with an installed capacity of 4,500 metric ton per annum (MTPA). In March 2005, the entity was reconstituted as a private limited company. VPIPL is engaged in manufacturing writing and printing papers (WPP) by using wastepaper as a major raw material. The manufacturing facility is in Patiala, Punjab. VPIPL has been manufacturing paper upto 40-120 grams per square metre (GSM).
