CARE Ratings Limited (CareEdge Ratings) had, vide its press release dated January 23, 2025, placed the rating(s) of Hibza Foods Private Limited (HFPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as HFPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. HFPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated December 09, 2025, December 19, 2025, December 29, 2025, among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CareEdge Ratings has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CareEdge Ratings opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

HFPL was incorporated in May 2017 by Mr. Ali Ahmad and Mr. Imteyaz Ahmad for setting up a rice milling and processing unit. The company is currently setting up a rice milling unit with aggregate installed capacity of 30,720 metric ton per annum at Madhubani, Bihar. The commercial operation is estimated to commence from December 2018.
