### Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. (CareEdge Ratings) had, vide its press release dated March 10, 2025, placed the rating(s) of Godaavari Labs Private Limited (GLPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as GLPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. GLPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated January 24, 2026, February 03, 2026, February 13, 2026 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CareEdge Ratings has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CareEdge Ratings opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

### About the Company

Godaavari Labs Private Limited (GLPL) was incorporated in the year 2013 and has proposed to set up a unit in Andhra Pradesh to manufacture Active Pharmaceuticals Ingredients (API) and intermediates for different therapeutic segment. The total project cost is estimated at Rs 232 crore proposed to be funded through bank debt of Rs 130 crore and remaining through promoters contribution.

**Status of non-cooperation with previous CRA:** Brickwork has continued the rating assigned to the bank facilities of GLPL into Issuer Not Cooperating category vide press release dated November 11, 2025 on account of its inability to carry out a review in the absence of requisite information.
