Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. (CareEdge Ratings) had, vide its press release dated March 24, 2025, placed the rating(s) of Prakash Engineers & Infraprojects Private Limited (PEIPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as PEIPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. PEIPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated February 07, 2026, February 17, 2026, February 27, 2026 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CareEdge Ratings has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CareEdge Ratings' opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

Users of this rating (including investors, lenders and the public at large) are hence requested to exercise caution while using the above rating(s).

The ratings assigned to bank facilities of PEIPL have been revised on account of non-availability of requisite information.

Analytical approach: Standalone changed from combined. Previously CARE had taken combined approach for Prakash Engineers & Infraprojects Private Limited and PECC as both these companies are into similar line of business, common promoter family, has fungibility of cash flows and has operational linkages. However, updated information is not available to ascertain financial linkages that warrant a continuation of combined approach thus the analytical approach has been changed to Standalone.

The company started off with small works in construction field till the company got their first big contract of building the part of Rajawadi Hospital. There were several big projects completed by the firm like the Wadi Bunder Fire Brigade Station, Concrete Roads etc. The company applies for tenders through bidding and receives contracts on the basis of the same. The company is registered in M.C.G.M., P.W.D.(Public Works Department), CIDCO, NMMC, TMC, MBPT & MBMC in
