### Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. (CareEdge Ratings) had, vide its press release dated June 18, 2025, placed the rating(s) of Indian Knives and Tools Company (IKTC) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as IKTC had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. IKTC continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated May 04, 2026, May 14, 2026, May 24, 2026 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CareEdge Ratings has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CareEdge Ratings opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

The entity procures required raw material namely steel, grinding wheels, abrasion resistance steel plate etc. from local suppliers. Further entity manufacturing various shapes, size, sharpness and thickness of industrial cutting instruments which find application mainly in paper and plastic industries and generated 100% of revenue from the domestic market only.
