Rationale and key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Limited (CareEdge Ratings) had, vide its press release dated June 17, 2025, placed the rating(s) of Maple Flexiblle LLP (MFL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as MFL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. MFL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated May 03, 2026, May 13, 2026, May 23, 2026 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CareEdge Ratings has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CareEdge Ratings' opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.

About the LLP

MFL is a Limited Liability Partnership Firm incorporated under Limited Liability Partnership Act, 2008 in December 2020. The LLP is started by 6 partners Amit Kumar Agarwal, Manish Singhania, Sanjay Khaitan, Govind Khaitan, Seema Khaitan and Manav Polymers Private Limited. The LLP is currently implementing a project for setting up manufacturing unit of heat shrink label, biaxially-oriented polypropylene wrap around label, multi-layered Laminates, low density polyethylene Collating/Shrink Films and other plastic packing/package materials. Annual production capacity being 30,74,400 kg for PVC shrink label, biaxiallyoriented polypropylene wrap around label, multi-layered Laminates, low density polyethylene Collating/Shrink Films and other plastic packing/package materials.

Status of non-cooperation with previous CRA: CRISIL has continued the ratings assigned to the bank facilities of MFL to 'Issuer Not Cooperating' category vide press release dated April 24, 2026 on account of its inability to carry out a review in the absence of the requisite information from the firm.
