CARE Ratings Limited (CareEdge Ratings) had, vide its press release dated July 29, 2025, placed the rating(s) of Cream Jewellery (CJ) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as CJ had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. CJ continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails dated June 14, 2026, June 25, 2026, July 04, 2026 among others.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CareEdge Ratings has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CareEdge Ratings' opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.
