Detailed Rationale & Key Rating Drivers

CARE Ratings Ltd. had, vide its press release dated March 02, 2021, placed the rating(s) of Associated Polytech Industries Private Limited (APIPL) under the 'issuer non-cooperating' category as APIPL had failed to provide information for monitoring of the rating and had not paid the surveillance fees for the rating exercise as agreed to in its Rating Agreement. APIPL continues to be non-cooperative despite repeated requests for submission of information through e-mails, phone calls and a letter/email dated January 16, 2022, January 26, 2022, February 05, 2022.

In line with the extant SEBI guidelines, CARE Ratings Ltd. has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information which however, in CARE Ratings Ltd.'s opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating.
