

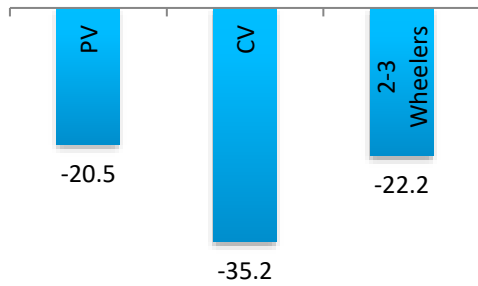

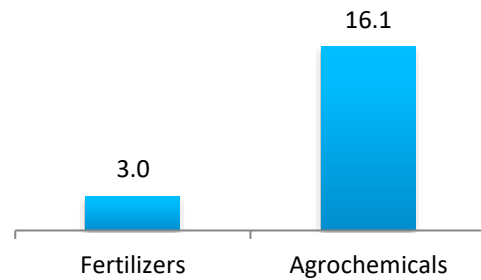
Chart 1: Operational Indicators of major manufacturing industries on a y-o-y basis (Unit: %)

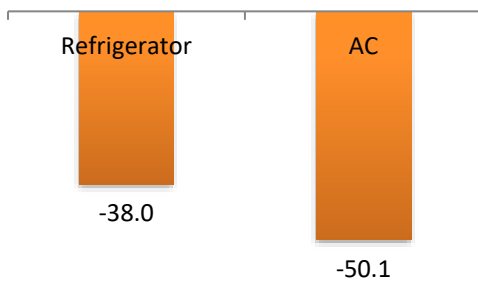

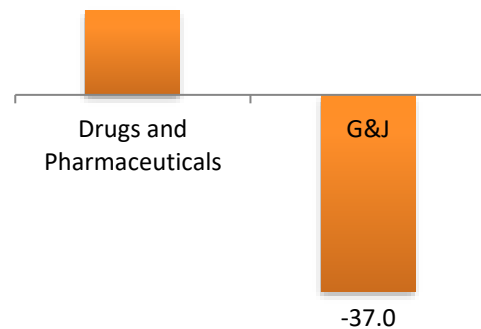

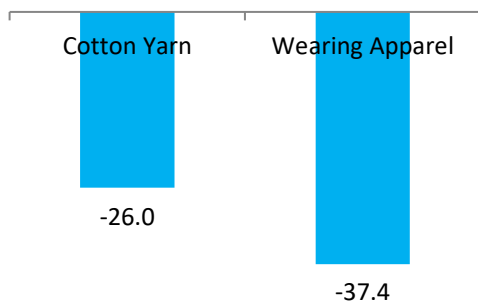

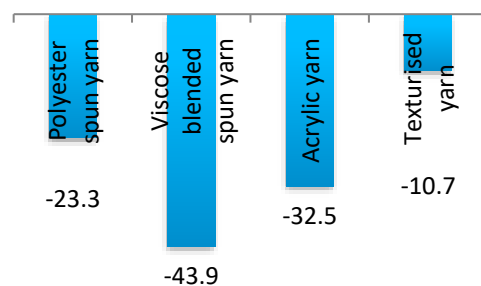

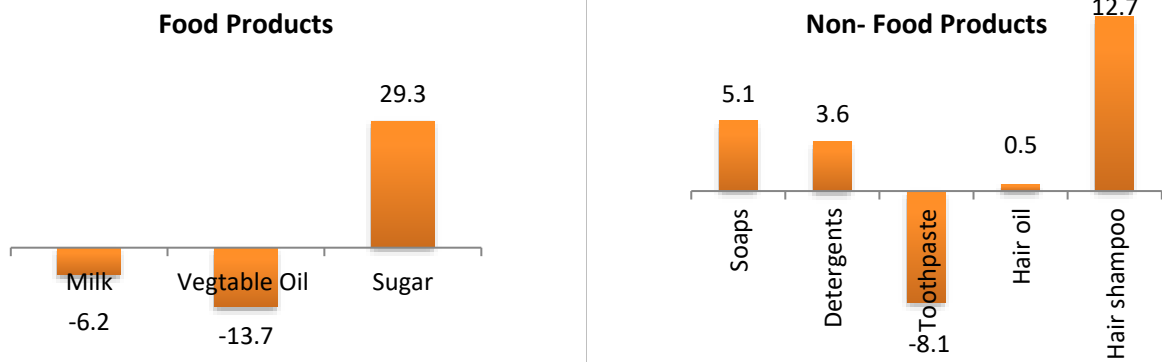

Chart 2: Cumulative Production on a y-o-y basis (Unit: %)



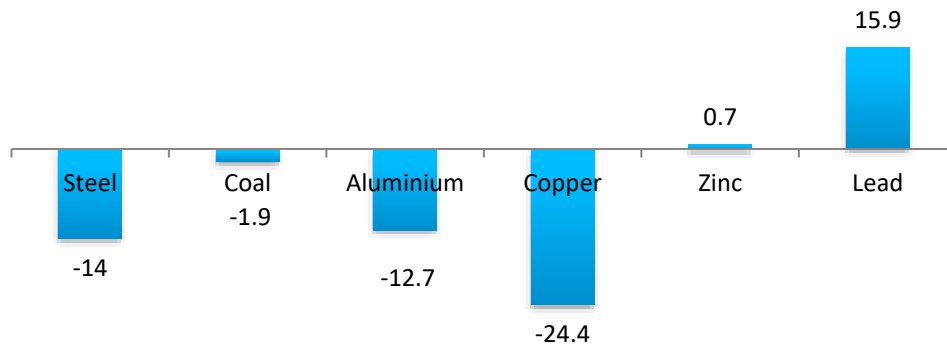

Chart 3: Cumulative Production on a y-o-y basis (Unit: %)

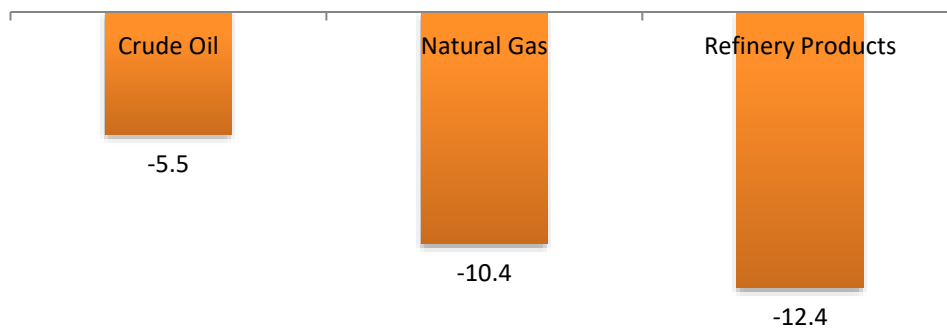

Chart 4: Cumulative Production on a y-o-y basis (Unit: %)

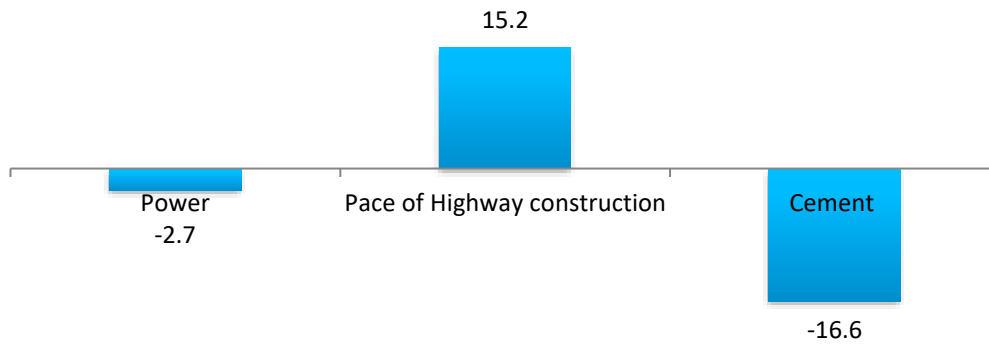

Chart 5: Cumulative Operational Indicators on a y-o-y basis (Unit: %)

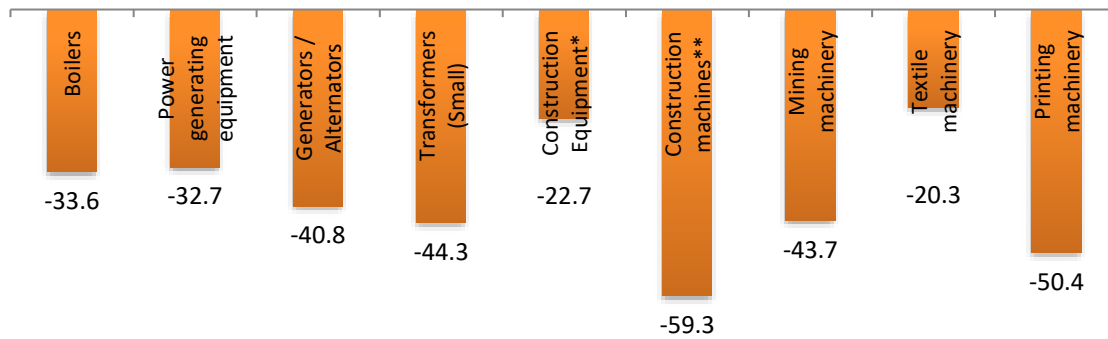

Chart 6: Industrial Production: Components of Capital Goods Index (Unit: %)

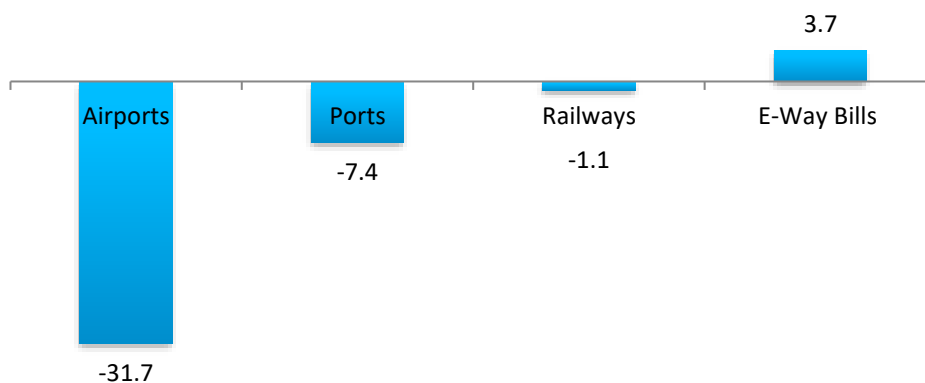

Chart 7: Cumulative Cargo Handled on a y-o-y basis (Unit: %)

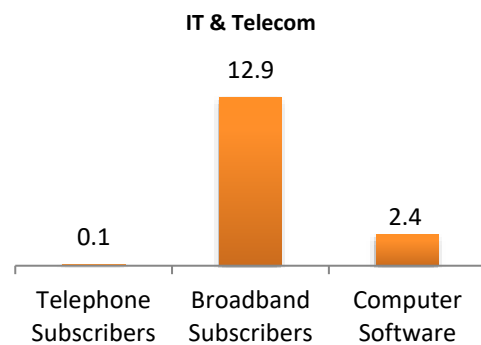
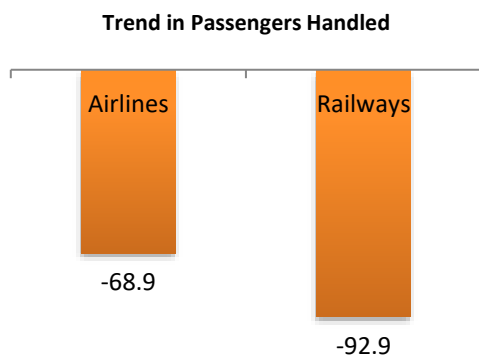
